Removed from Transcripts

In keeping with large districts across the state and country, CCSD is no longer publishing class rank on student transcripts effective SY 2019-2020.



Better for Students

By removing class rank from student transcripts, CCSD graduates will be more competitive for college admission and scholarships.

Big Picture



Removing class rank from transcripts positions CCSD students to be as competitive as possible, particularly when CCSD graduates are compared to other district graduates. Scholarships earned and college acceptance rates should be positively impacted.

Other Important Notes:

- Rank has much less significance (if any) to college admissions officers than a range of other factors including GPA, rigor of the curriculum, etc.
- The differences in high achieving students are usually statistically insignificant. Therefore it is misleading to compare them to one another.
- Use of ranking can add to or induce high levels of anxiety and can negatively impact a child's mental health.
